The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong (HSUHK) Principal Recommended Admission Scheme for 2024-25

1. Objective

The Scheme aims at giving due recognition to students who have made distinguished achievements in academic and/or non-academic areas such as sports, music, arts, etc., contributed to community services, or demonstrated leadership abilities. Admission quotas have been reserved for eligible nominees and conditional offers will be given before the release of HKDSE examination results.

To stimulate students with extraordinarily, distinguished performance in academic and/or non-academic areas to study at HSUHK, firm offers, regardless of their HKDSE examination results, will be issued via the Scheme alongside conditional offers.

2. <u>Eligibility</u>

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to be considered under the Scheme:

- Local students / residents with right of abode in Hong Kong; and
- Applicants for the NMTSS programme at the HSUHK; and
- School applicants attending the HKDSE examination; and
- Outstanding academic achievements; and/or
- Applicants from our school fulfilling the following grade requirements:
 - Grade C or above in conduct in both S.4 and S.5, and
 - Being in the top 50% based on their academic results in the first and second terms of S.4 and S.5, as well as the Uniform Test in S.6.
- Distinguished achievements in non-academic areas, e.g. sports, music, arts, etc.; or
- Outstanding leadership qualities, e.g. Head Prefects, Presidents of Students' Unions; or
- Participation in community services

3. Nomination Quota for Each School:

Each school can nominate up to 5 students. From 27th May, 2024 (before the release of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination results), the school and the nominees will be notified of one of the following admission results:

- I. Granting the nominee a direct admission offer; or
- II. Granting the nominee a conditional admission offer; or
- III. Not considered.

4. <u>Application Procedures</u>

- Before joining the Scheme, the nominee(s) **MUST** first submit admission application via the HSUHK Undergraduate Application System (UAS) or Electronic Advance Application System for Post-secondary Programmes (E-APP) and **complete ALL the admission application procedures (including uploading the HKID Card / valid travel document, school report(s) for the recent two academic years to UAS and settling the application fees).**
- Each nominee MUST submit Student Personal Profile with ALL copies of certificates/ awards.
- All recommendations should be **submitted via SCHOOL.**

5. <u>Application Deadline</u>

Students interested may submit the Student Personal Profile with ALL copies of certificates / awards to Miss Lo Ming-yu (MY) on or before <u>1st February (Thursday),</u> <u>2024</u>.

6. <u>Notes:</u>

If students wish to apply for admission to the programmes **under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/ Sectors (SSSDP)*, they are required to apply through** the School Principal's Nominations (SPN) scheme in JUPAS, instead of the Principal Recommended Admission Scheme.

*Programmes under SSSDP include:

- Bachelor of Business Administration (Honours) in Supply Chain Management,
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Actuarial Studies and Insurance,
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Applied Computing,
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Data Science and Business Intelligence,
- Bachelor of Management Science and Information Management (Honours) or
- Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Art and Design
