About Our School





Buddhist Wong Fung Ling College is a secondary school in the Wan Chai District. We put forth our greatest effort to assist students to achieve their full potentials.

Being sponsored by Buddhist Association, our college is run on the teachings of Buddha and upholds the principles of realizing the ultimate truth, manifesting innate compassion' as the school motto. Our school strives for the provision of quality education and the nurture of life-long learning as well as whole-person development among students.

Through education, we aim at nurturing the students to become respectable youngsters who take civic responsibilities towards the local community and are ready to serve at all times.

We provide quality education for students in order to foster their healthy growth, to boost their bilingual and trilingual dialect competence and to develop their self-learning ability with the help of Multimedia Innovative Unit (M.I.U.)

Apart from routine academic weeks like English Week, Chinese Cultural Week and Putonghua Days, we are also actively coaching students for Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival, Writing Contest and Story Telling Competitions, and has seen years of excellent achievements. Media Innovation Unit is known for its prolific campus TV programs and has obtained distinguished achievements with arrays of awards. A total of 641 counts of head were conferred awards, certificates and commendation prize in 144 items, covering 149 in 53 academics, 104 in 37 physical education, 85 in 11 aesthetics, 303 in others plus scholarship.

Since 2012, we have students of various ethnicities. They come from China, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Thailand, and the United Kingdom. We strive to provide students with a healthy, multi-cultural learning environment.





Our Teachers

Our School Principal and 96% of our teachers are Masters and Bachelor Degree holders. All are qualified, trained and experienced subject teachers.

Assistant Teachers for NCS students

We have 2 Chinese Teaching Assistants and 1 non-Chinese experienced Assistant Teacher who speaks fluent Urdu, English and Cantonese. They assist teachers and help students to manage their homework plus giving support to the Chinese and English Curriculum. They also serve as a bridge of communication between parents in need and the teachers and school staff.

Language Support

- Our school uses English as the medium of instruction for S.1 and S2 Non Chinese Students (NCS) in English Language, Mathematics, Science and Integrated Humanities while Chinese medium is used for other subjects like Chinese Language, Putonghua, Computer Studies*, Visual Arts*, Physical Education* and Music*. For S3, other subjects like History, Geography, Physics, Biology and Chemistry are also taught in English medium. (*English Extended learning activities are in place)
- Our school official languages are Chinese and English. In order to build a favourable language learning environment, we encourage students to communicate with each other in Chinese and English. We have a full-time Native English Teacher (NET) and a large batch of English Ambassadors to boost the language proficiency and confidence of our students. This ensures a promising potential for future endeavour in career and education pursuit among our students.
- Our Chinese Language curriculum is suitable for students who wish to learn the Chinese language from the core. Students can choose between Chinese Language of the HKDSE public examinations and the GCE Chinese Examination. This option will enable NCS students to enter the Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) for university admission in 9 JUPAS participating universities or the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions / Sectors (SSSDP) institutions.

Free After-school Tutorial Classes

- We offer Enrichment and Remedial classes to well equip senior-form students for public examination while after-school tutorials and summer bridging courses to help junior form students settle in are well in place. Challenging questions for assessment are general practices for subject tests and examinations in response to high-ability students. Enrichment projects like Writing Course, Oratory Skill Training Class, Speech Training Course, Critical Thinking Training Class and more to name are tailored for gifted students.
- ✤ We provide Chinese lessons conducted by our Chinese teachers to students who need help with their homework or revision for dictations, tests or examinations.
- Our Old Boys & Girls Club provides one-on-one tutorials for NCS students who wish to have individual lessons with our graduated students. Through this programme, students can experience a one-on-one tutorial and seek more in-depth help with their load of homework and overcome the barrier of learning the Chinese Language.

Transportation & Book Allowance

- Students who have financial difficulties can apply for the Financial Assistance Schemes through the Student Finance Office (SFO). They are:
 - > The School Textbook Assistance (TA) Scheme
 - > The Student Travel Subsidy (STS) Scheme
 - > The Subsidy Scheme for Internet Access Charges (SIA)

Application forms can be obtained from the school office or downloaded from the Student Finance Office website.

- Students can also apply for financial assistance through other private schemes at our school.
- \diamond We provide scholarships for students with outstanding performance throughout the school year.









Interest Course Activities

- ☆ We offer more than 50 clubs/school teams with more than 300 activities of various natures, ranging from academics, interest, service and conservation, religion, physical and aesthetics items. They are conducted after school and on Saturdays. We help to foster the whole-person development for students through our activities and social life in order for them to explore their full potentials and adaptation to the living life style in Hong Kong.
- ✤ Financial assistance can be provided for students with finance difficulties through the Hong Kong Jockey Club Life-Wide Learning Fund.
- Aesthetic Studies and Applied Learning are also provided to students with courses such as make-up, multimedia, childcare and more available to senior form students (S.4-S.6) combining with Student Learning Portfolio to widen their horizon and nurture whole-person development.

Enriching Multicultural Learning Environment



In order to cultivate a healthy, multicultural environment, our school takes on the following measures:

- \diamond Special Religious & Cultural Holidays
 - We accept and grant special holidays for NCS students in accordance with their important religious and cultural needs.
- \diamond Special School Uniforms for Religious Reasons
 - We understand some female students may want to wear long white stockings or the long white pants, white headscarf and white blouses to cover their arms, legs and heads in addition to our uniform. A written application to the School Principal and Disciplinary Teacher is required for such requests to be granted.
