Uniform Test/Exam Regulations

- 1) Those attending the first section of the uniform test must report to designated room/venue at or before 8:00 a.m. and wait for the test to commence. For other tests, students should be present at respective room/venue 10 minutes prior to the start of the test(s).
- 2) Students should put all their books, notes and personal belongings in their bags/school bags, which are to be placed under their chairs. Those who have no bags must place their personal belongings at the front of the exam venue.
- 3) Students are not allowed to borrow any materials from peers inside the venue after they have entered the exam venue.
- 4) Students should only use calculators pad-printed with the “H.K.E.A.A. APPROVED” label.
- 5) Students should observe absolute silence in the exam venue.
- 6) No one is allowed to leave early during the test/exam.
- 7) Students must stop writing immediately when the centre supervisor announces that the test/exam time is up.
- 8) Students should remain seated when the text/exam is finished, and wait quietly for the invigilators to collect their test papers till all examination material is well handled.
- 9) Students may leave the test/exam venue only upon hearing the announcement of dismissal made by the centre supervisor.
- 10) Those violating any of the test/exam regulations might be disqualified of respective subject marks and receive a demerit point.
- 11) If the school closes due to inclement weather, all tests scheduled that day will be postponed until further notice.
- 12) Students absent from the test must notify the School Office by telephone before the commencement of the first session of the test.
- 13) Absentee must submit valid proof document to teacher(s) of respective subject(s) (e.g. those who are absent due to sickness must submit medical certificate issued by a doctor). Failing to do so would result in him/her being disqualified of the test score.
- 14) Students must finish taking all the scheduled tests of the day before leaving school.
