The film takes place in New York. It is about a couple named Nick Young and his

girlfriend, Rachel Chu, who is an economics professor at New York University. They

travel to Singapore for the wedding of his best friend, Collin, who is marrying Araminta

Lee. Rachel visits her colleague friend, Peik Lin, who is shocked when she tells her that
