自由身工作者的工作不定時, 需要良好的時間管理,而且工 作量及薪金都取決於自己的付 出,所以自理能力很重要。

▶ 影片剪接:

影片拍攝後需要整理及處理大量素材,對影片或故事要有一定的分析、重組、節奏控制能力。現時大多數入職人士都具相關學歷。

<u> 音樂</u>:

作為教育及演奏者,需要一定的 樂理及演奏基礎。而一般樂器導 師需要相關資歷或樂器具8級或 以上水平,需有愛心及良好的表 達能力。

工作內容

● 後期剪接:

收集拍攝素材後,先進行初剪,再與導演及各拍攝後期制作人員(例如調色、 混音)合作製作出成品。

● 作育人才:

於各學校課餘時間教授樂器班及鼓隊訓練。需預先準備教材及樂譜,除了創作 節奏外,亦要為鼓隊設計肢體動作。

● 音樂演出:

需要出席樂隊綵排及訓練,處理及安排 演出內容。


