Nomination Criteria

Nominees must:

- demonstrate excellent performance in academic areas;
- contribute to social services; or
demonstrate excellent performance in non-academic areas, e.g. sports, music, arts, etc.; or
demonstrate leadership abilities
- be prepared to commit themselves to the betterment of our society.
- be rated “Excellent” or “Good” in the 12 attributes in the School Reference Report (Industriousness, Independence of mind, Sense of responsibility, Ability to work with others, Maturity, Leadership, Conduct, Perseverance, Analytical power, Initiative, Creativity, Ability to communicate); and
- place the chosen EdUHK undergraduate programme(s) as their Band A choice(s) in the JUPAS application (NOT including Higher Diploma in Early Childhood Education).

Number of Admission Quotas under the Scheme

Each school can nominate up to **TEN and additional FOUR Non-Chinese speaking students** to the Scheme.

Features

- Nominees shortlisted by the respective subject departments will be interviewed in June (before the release of HKDSE examination results). Students with excellent performance in the interview will be given priority of admission, if deemed appropriate.
- Nominees will be invited to join the "Buddy Scheme" under which one of EdUHK undergraduate students will become their buddy. He/she will contact the nominees after the HKDSE examination to share his/her learning experiences at the University and provide useful tips and advice throughout the admission process.

* For NCS students who have met the specified circumstances as announced by the Education Bureau (EDB), the University accepts the Alternative Qualifications in Chinese Language (ACL), such as GCE (A-level / AS-level) (Grade E), GCE (O-Level) (Grade C), GCSE (Grade C / Grade 4), IGCSE (Grade C / Grade 4) and HKDSE ApL(C) (Attained), as equivalent to Level 3 in DSE Chinese Language for meeting the minimum Chinese Language requirements and for calculation of the related admission scores, except for programmes which require students to have possessed a good command of Chinese (i.e. JS8003, JS8005 and JS8674).
