2016/2017 Notice to Parents A48_e Measures to Cope with Tropical Cyclones and Heavy Persistent Rain

The Tropical Cyclones and Rainstorm Warning Signal issued by the Hong Kong Government is to alert the public about the occurrence of inclement weather and reduce the disruption caused. In view of this, the school will take the following measures to cope with any bad weather condition. Parents are also advised to pay attention to these measures and make corresponding decision to ensure students' safety.

- 1. Once the Hong Kong Observatory (HKO) issues typhoon signal 8 or red/black rainstorm warning and the Education Bureau announces the suspension of classes before 6 a.m., students should stay home. If the announcement of such matter is made between 6 a.m. and 8 a.m., students who have not left home may stay home, while those who have left home for school are to stay at school or any other safe shelters and return home upon safe conditions.
- 2. If the Education Bureau announces the suspension of classes in certain areas, please be aware of whether your living place belongs to the affected area; please note that the campus is located at Eastern Hospital Road in Wan Chai District.
- 3. Those unable to return to school/late for school due to tropical cyclones/rainstorm will not be subject to any punishment.
- 4. Red/Black Rainstorm signal issued during school hours does not imply suspension of lessons, and school will finish as scheduled. If Black Rainstorm signal is still in effect after school, all students are required to stay in the school (except for those escorted home by parents). If Red Rainstorm signal is still in effect after school, the school will assess the weather condition according to the information given by the HKO and traffic status before deciding whether students would be allowed to leave the premise on their own. Such announcement would be made before 4:30 p.m. that day (parents who want to escort their children home should notify the school by phone before 4 p.m.).

5.	The announcement of suspension of school by Education Bureau does not necessarily apply to
	public exam. Unless HKEAA makes announcements about cancellation or postponement, the
	public examination is to be held as scheduled.
