Notice to Parents 2016/2017 A7 Musical Instrument For All Scheme

Dear Parents,

To promote whole-person development of students, the school has launched the "One Person One Instrument" Scheme, under which students would receive basic training of musical instruments and conducting. Participants would also be joining the Chinese Orchestra or Brass Band of the school and give actual performances. The scheme serves to boost students' creativity, imagination, confidence and problem-solving skills, allowing them to work as a team and learn about the importance of team spirit and discipline. The school would continue providing funds and employing renowned musicians and professional conductors to ensure the quality of this programme.

Sponsored by the school, the one-year scheme encompasses a total of 28 lessons, each lasting for one hour, followed by another hour of orchestral training. Students would be assigned to join either the Chinese Orchestra or Brass Band. Training for the Chinese Orchestra starts from 12:00 nn. to 1:00 p.m, while that for the Brass Band starts from 11:15 a.m. to 12:15p.m. The corresponding tuition fee is HKD\$3,000, and payments can be made one-off or in 2 installments.

Those who are interested in singing may consider joining the School Choir. The team also provides 28 lessons throughout the year. Members are required to join the training sessions held on Thursdays after school from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. The tuition for the choir is HKD\$500.

The school would arrange the classes to students in accordance with their choices, strength in music and the number of places available of different courses. Details are to be announced. Please also note that no make-up classes or refund would be offered to those who are absent, apply for leaves or withdraw from the scheme.

We hereby promote this scheme in hopes of helping students master an instrument of their choice and giving them a sense of achievement when performing on stage. We believe your support is vital for the programme to be successful, therefore we encourage students to actively take part in it.
