Reminder for Application for Extra-Curricular Activities

1. Teachers in charge reserve the right to decide on the members should the number of applicants exceeds that of the places available.

- 2. For all academics clubs and interest classes, regular meetings and training sessions will be held once a week/every two weeks. Other interest groups will hold 3 to 4 activities every term.
- 3. Extra-curricular activities are usually held after school, while some of which might take place during lunch time or on weekends / Sundays.
- 4. Participants of tutor-led classes have to pay tutor fee. Other academics clubs require members to pay a HKD\$10 for membership fee and extra charges might be collected when situation deems this necessary.
- 5. Parents should remind students to be dressed in regular school uniform / respective uniform when they attend any activities at school. Those who fail to comply will be subjected to disciplinary action.
- 6. Corresponding notices to parents will be issued before the activities take place.
- 7. Students can take part in <u>at most two</u> activities but <u>must join at least one</u>. Those applying for two activities might be assigned to one activity only. Only S.2 students and aged 13 and a half or above are eligible for joining The Hong Kong Award for Young People.
- 8. Interest / academics clubs / societies (as listed in part A) do not openly recruit members, but students are welcome to join their activities held occasionally.
- 9. Students being appointed as committee members of any academics clubs (as listed in part A) will automatically become regular members of respective clubs. They may be exempted from joining other clubs upon submitting application.
- 10. Apart from training qualified students to join open competitions, school teams (as listed in part B) will also run promotional activities at school for all students to take part in.
- 11. Membership of all school teams is valid for ONE year only and hence members must receive approval from the teachers- in-charge for renewal of their status.
- 12. Committee members of interest Groups listed in part C must be regular members of respective bodies.
- 13. Students in need of any financial assistance may apply for Life-Wide Learning Fund (please submit the application together with the reply slip).
