Information about COVID-19 Vaccination and Anti-virus Measures

Dear Parents,

1. Regarding vaccination against COVID-19:

- (1). As the new academic school year 2021-2022 is round the corner, the Education Bureau just announced that half-day face-to-face lessons and examinations could resume.
- (2). If individual school could meet the following requirements:
  - i. At least 70% of school staff (teaching and non-teaching staff included) has received 2 jabs of COVID-19 vaccination plus 14 days elapsed, **and**
  - ii. At least 70% of student population has received 2 jabs of COVID-19 vaccination with 14 days elapsed, Education Bureau would take into consideration of such situation to allow for resumption of normal school life such as full-day lessons, lunch arrangement and extra-curricular activities.
  - iii. However, if only individual forms of students could meet the above 2<sup>nd</sup> requirement, those forms related could also be granted green light to resume full-day lessons and other learning activities.
- (3) The School will need to update information of students of 12-year-old or above receiving vaccination (on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2021) for responsive arrangement of lesson operation be duly made. Please complete the reply slip to be returned to respective class teachers with COVID-19 vaccination record (if applicable). For queries, feel free to contact either your class teachers or Ms SIU Man-yee, teacher-in-charge of School Affairs at 25779485.

2. Regarding anti-virus measures and personal Hygiene:

Commencing 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2021, people who frequent the School must have either received the 1<sup>st</sup> jab of COVID-19 or be undertaking COVID-19 tests every two weeks with negative result. They include but not confine to teaching and non-teaching staff, service providers of in-house programme such as instructors of interest groups or voluntary workers. The school tuckshop will remain open while their staff adhere strictly to all anti-virus policy and observe personal hygiene and sanitization measures.

In order that students can continue with their learning in a clean and safe setting, the joint-effort of both parents and students is of utmost importance. We earnestly appeal to parents to not only to step

up on household cleanliness but also to keep close eye on your child's health.

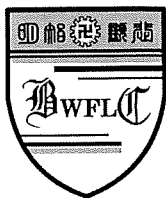
- Immediate consultation with a doctor in the case of development of symptoms, especially a fever is of utmost importance.
- Help your child to take and record his/her body temperature every morning before he/she leaves for the School. Sign on the stipulated Body Temperature Record Sheet (see Appendix) daily which your child should show to class teacher for checking.
- To avoid infection, please urge your child to wear surgical masks while commuting to and from the School, also facial tissues should come handy
- Student who has recovered from COVID-19 but is still in the 14-day quarantine period should refrain from coming to the School. Students whose residence has been issued Mandatory Testing Notice should not come back to school. Students who are categorized as Person Subject to Compulsory Testing under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Test for Certain Persons) Regulation (Cap. 599) should undergo testing as soon as possible and produce proof of documents (e.g. mobile SMS, test result) stipulating negative to the school. Students who cannot resume school for the above reasons would be handled with grace in accordance with the existing policy.
- Parents should call the School at 2577 9485 to notify Ms SIU Man-yeet at no time in case you encounter the following conditions so that the School can take proper measures:
  - Your child is a confirmed case of COVID-19;
  - Your child is defined as Close Contacts himself/herself or co-habiting with some Close Contacts of COVID-19 by HPC;
  - Persons Subject to Compulsory Testing under Regulation (Cap. 599) receiving COVID-19 Test; and
  - Residence being issued Mandatory Testing Notice and hence your child cannot leave for school.

The School takes all efforts to maintain a hygienic campus to safeguard the health of our students. However, in view of the volatility of the pandemic, the School promises to keep abreast with all related issues but also urge parents to pay attention to all announcements of the Education Bureau. The School will update parents through the School intranet and myID Channel Plus notices.

Last but not least, please be reminded that keeping your child away from crowds to minimize the risk of getting infected is of paramount importance. Let us work together for the soonest resumption of a normal and healthy life for all stake-holders upon recession of the pandemic.
