# Notice to Parents 2021/2022 A34 e Information about Activity Day for Senior Secondary Students

# Dear Parents,

The Sports Day scheduled on 3rd and 7th December will be cancelled in view of COVID-19 pandemic. The 3<sup>rd</sup> December will be made The Activity Day for Junior form students while senior form students are to have the day off. The 7th December, Tuesday, will be replaced with The Activity Day for Senior Secondary students. Details are as follows:

> Activity Venue: Siu Sai Wan Sports Ground

8:15 am (Students may enter the venue at 7:45 am) ➤ Roll Call

> Finish Time approximately 5 pm

> Attire allowed: 1. Proper school uniform and black shoes (Organising Committee members can be dressed in designated School Team windbreaker),

2. Winter P.E. uniform, OR

3. Uniform Group members rendering service to the event may be dressed in respective uniforms

- Attire for the event: 1. Summer P.E. uniform (students may wear sweaters / winter P.E. uniform if the weather is cold), OR
  - 2. Class uniform (school permission needs to be sought in advance)

## Remarks:

- Those dressed in the school P.E. uniform must wear sports shoes permitted by the school.
- Student helpers choose either the school winter P.E. uniform or the School uniform to go alongside sports shoes permitted by the school.
- Cheering team uniform/class uniform must be worn only in the sports venue and changed to regular school/sports uniform before students leave the sports ground for lunch and after school.
- > Lunch arrangement: The activity venue will be closed for lunch-time sanitization and hence students need to lunch out at nearby eateries whilst observing all anti-virus measures.

## > Other reminders:

- Students must bring with them their student cards and HKID cards. 1.
- It takes approximately 30 minutes to travel from Causeway Bay to the sports venue. 2. Students are advised to leave home early to avoid being late.
- Students must keep their personal belongings secure. Those joining the competition may 3. seek temporary custodian of their belongings from fellow classmates.
- Students must abide by all regulations set for the use of sports facilities and keep the venue 4. clean.

- 5. Students are not allowed to bring any newspapers, magazines, toys and headphones into the activity venue. They should be attentive to the competition and cheer for participants.
- 6. The event might be cancelled should inclement weather occur. Students should take heed of radio broadcast. The School will make necessary announcement on its website and myID Channel Plus App about any updates. Parents are advised to browse the school's website at 7:00 am or make inquiry to the school office that day for information about any emergency arrangement.
- 7. All students, including those who are not joining any track and field events, must attend the group event. For any absence due to unexpected sickness, students need to call the School to report sick leave and submit medical certificate to respective class teacher the following school day. Students who need to apply for casual leave must seek approval from class teacher with parents letter prior to the Activity Day.
