## Remarks:

- 1. There will be no morning assembly during the Uniform Test Week. Students must be at school before 8:00 a.m..
- 2. Those students attending the first session of the Uniform Test must enter the designated room/venue at or before 8:00 a.m. and wait for the test to commence. For other sessions, students should report to the respective room/venue 10 minutes prior to the start of the test(s).
- 3. The School Library will open as usual during the Uniform Test Week.
- 4. If the school closes due to inclement weather, all the tests scheduled on that day will be postponed and students will be informed of the make-up tests later. The tests following the affected day will take place as scheduled.

## **Uniform Test/Exam Regulations**

- 1. Those students attending the first session of the uniform test or exam must report to the designated room/venue at or before 8:00 am and wait for the test or exam to commence. For other sessions, students should be present at respective room/venue 10 minutes prior to the start of the test(s) or exam(s).
- Students should put all their books, notes and personal belongings in their bags/school bags, which are to be placed under their chairs. Those who have no bags must place their personal belongings at the front of the exam venue.
- 3. Students are not allowed to borrow any materials from peers inside the venue after they have entered the exam venue.
- 4. Students should only use calculators pad-printed with the 「H.K.E.A.A. APPROVED」 label.
- 5. Students should keep quiet all the time when they are in the exam venue.
- 6. No one is allowed to leave early during the test/exam.
- 7. Students must stop writing immediately when the center supervisor announces that the test/exam time is up.
- 8. Students should remain seated when the test/exam is finished, and wait quietly for the invigilators to collect the test or exam papers and check their total number.
- 9. Students may leave the test/exam venue only upon hearing the announcement of dismissal made by the center supervisor.
- 10. Those students violating any of the test/exam regulations will be receiving the following punishment:
  - a. Disqualified of the respective subject marks
  - b. Receive a demerit
- 11. If the school closes due to inclement weather, all the tests or exams scheduled on that day will be postponed until further notice.
- 12. Those students absent on a test or exam day must notify the School Office by telephone before the first session of the test or exam starts.
- 13. Absentees must submit valid proof document to the teacher of respective subject (e.g.Those who are absent due to sickness must submit medical certificate issued by a doctor.). Failing to do so would result in him/her being disqualified of the test or exam score.
- 14. Students must finish taking all the scheduled tests or exams of the day before leaving the school.
