Exam Regulations

1. Those students attending the first session of the exam must report to the designated room/venue at or before 8:00 am and wait for the exam to commence. For other sessions, students should be present at respective room/venue 10 minutes prior to the start of the exams.
2. Students should put all their books, notes and personal belongings in their bags/school bags, which are to be placed under their chairs. Those who have no bags must place their personal belongings at the front of the exam venue.
3. If students have brought a mobile phone, they should check to see if it has been switched off. They are advised to take out the battery from their phone and put their phone and battery into their bags.
4. Students are not allowed to borrow any materials from peers inside the venue after they have entered the exam venue.
5. Students should only use calculators pad-printed with the "HKEAA APPROVED" label.
6. Students should keep quiet all the time when they are in the exam venue.
7. No one is allowed to leave early during the exam.
8. Students must stop writing immediately when the centre supervisor announces that the exam time is up.
9. Students should remain seated when the exam is finished, and wait quietly for the Invigilators to collect the exam papers and check their total number.
10. Students may leave the exam venue only upon hearing the announcement of dismissal made by the centre supervisor.
11. Those students violating any of the exam regulations will receive the following punishment:
 - A. They will be disqualified of the respective subject mark.
 - B. They will receive a demerit.
12. If the School closes due to inclement weather, all the exams scheduled on that day will be postponed until further notice.
13. Those students absent on an exam day must notify the School Office by telephone before the first session of the exam starts.
14. Absentees must submit valid proof document to the teacher of respective subject
(e.g. Those who are absent due to sickness must submit medical certificate issued on the same day of absence by a doctor. Parents' letter must be submitted for emergency leave.)
Zero mark will be given if students are absent with no solid reason.
15. Students must finish taking all the scheduled exams of the day before leaving the School.
