- 1. All S6 students must attend. Absence without valid reason may affect the grading of this public examination.
- 2. Briefing session: A pre-departure briefing session (in Cantonese) will be held on 3rd November, 2023 (Friday) from 2:55 pm to 3:45 pm at the school hall. Parents will be invited to attend to learn about the details of tour arrangement. All form six students must attend the session.
- 3. Documents: Students must bring valid travel documents [Hong Kong Identity Card and Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents / Visa] for departure from Hong Kong.
- 4. Travel insurance has already been purchased by the Education Bureau.

- 5. Students should wear school sports uniforms and follow the same grooming standards as those of regular school days. The study tour day is considered a normal school day, and students are expected to learn with a serious attitude, behave courteously, and follow school rules. Please be mindful of the instructions in Attachment 1 and Attachment 2 regarding matters to be considered during the study tour.
- 6. If a student requests to withdraw before departure, the withdrawing student must pay any additional expenses incurred due to their withdrawal. The Education Bureau may also revoke funding for those students, resulting in the students having to pay the related tour fees and additional withdrawal costs.
- 7. The Education Bureau, the organizing agency, and our school may take photos and videos during the Mainland study tour. These photos and video clips may be used in future for display on the Education Bureau's or our school's websites, in other activities, and may also be shared with other government departments for presentation on various media and platforms.
