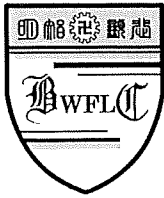
Activities are subsidized by the Community-based Projects, no fee is applied. Preference is to be given to students who are on Textbook Assistance Scheme.
