Remarks:

- 1. The exam venue of 28/2(Mon) BAFS and 8/3(Tue) Economics is B205.
- 2. The exam venue of 8/3(Tue) Visual Arts is B206 and that of Geography is B203.
- 3. The exam venue of 9/3(Wed) Chinese Language (NCS) (3) is D602.
- 4. The exam venue of 10/3(Thur) History is B203.
- 5. The exam venue of 12/3(Sat) Tourism and Hospitality Studies is B206.
- 6. 14/3(Mon) and 15/3(Tue) are dates for paper checking and S6 students have to return to school as normal. (The date of paper-checking for Tourism and Hospitality Studies is 26/3(Sat))

Term Test/ Examination Rules

- Students must take their own body temperature on daily basis and wear their own surgical mask properly (the mask should be covering the students' mouth, nose and chin completely). Also, students have to clean their hands with their own hand sanitizer or that provided by the school placed outside the examination venue.
- 2. Students facing a mandatory quarantine or awaiting the result of the coronavirus disease compulsory test should not attend the examination. Only students with negative testing result would be approved to enter the examination venue.
- 3. Candidates attending the first session of examination should enter and be seated at the New Hall by 8:00 a.m.; for other sessions of the examinations, candidates should enter the examination venue 15 minutes prior to the starting time of the examination.
- 4. Candidates should put their textbooks, notes and personal belonging into their bag along with their pencil box/bag and put the bag under their chairs. If the candidates do not have a bag, their personal belongings should be placed in the front stage of the examination venue.
- 5. After entering the examination venue, candidates are not allowed to borrow any things.
- The calculator used by the candidates must bear the 「H.K.E.A.A. APPROVED」 label ∘
- 7. Candidates must observe silence whenever they are in the examination venue.
- 8. No candidates are allowed to leave the examination venue early.
- 9. Candidates must stop writing after the 'Time is up' announcement.
- 10. At the end of the examination, candidates should remain seated and wait quietly and patiently for the teacher in the examination venue to collect the examination paper.
- 11. Candidates are not allowed to leave and should remain on their seat until the teacher announces 'You are allowed to leave the venue'.
- 12. Candidates caught cheating in the examination would face the following disciplinary action:
 - a. The score of the paper would round down to zero
 - b. The student concerned would receive a Minor demerit.

- 13. If the Education Department announces that all schools should close because of weather conditions during the Exam period, the exams will be deferred until further notice.
- 14. Students who cannot attend the examination must inform the school by phone prior to the start of the first session of examination.
- 15. Students who cannot attend the examination must present a valid supporting document to their teacher to explain their reason for their absence (A medical certificate for sick leave and a Parent letter for such emergency personal leave). Students who cannot present substantial evidence to justify their absence would score '0' mark in the examination concerned.
- 16. Students must finish all examinations of the day before they leave the campus.
