2021/2022 Notice to Parents No. A53_4e Information about COVID-19 Post-special Holiday Lesson Arrangements

Dear S5 Parents,

HKSAR Government announced resumption of half-day face-to-face lessons in stages commencing 19th April. The School is making the captioned arrangements as per instructions by EDB, details of which are as follows:

1. Lesson Arrangement

- 1.1 Senior Form students will have real-time lessons in the afternoon from 22nd April, Friday to 28th April, Thursday as the School has to deploy large number of teaching staff as HKDSE invigilators on those mornings. Refer to Appendix 1 for Timetable of lessons.
- 1.2 29th April will be rescheduled as Teacher Development Day and hence there will not be school for all students. The revised school calendar will be disseminated upon resumption of face-to-face lessons.
- 1.3 Half-day face-to-face lessons will resume on 3rd May, Tuesday. School hours run from 8:00 am to 1:15pm. Please refer to Appendix 2 for details.
- 1.4 The 3 missing days of examination of the 1st term will take place one week after lesson resumption, i.e. from 10th May Tuesday to 12th May Thursday in the same order of events. Students are strongly advised to be serious with their revision for a satisfactory result.

2. Summer Uniform

Students can choose between winter and summer school uniform to wear to school but mandatory change to summer uniform will take effect on 10th May, Tuesday. Students can make their own purchase of their uniform by visiting designated uniform supplier, details are as follows:

3. Home School Cooperation

Class teachers of your child will contact parents during the period between 20th April, Wednesday and 27th April, Wednesday for thorough communication of matters regarding your child's behaviour in this special holiday and clarification of any queries over the present arrangements.

4. Others

- 4.1 As of homework assigned for special holiday: may we urge you to supervise earnest completion of all holiday assignments of your child for submission upon return to the School.

4.2 COVID-19 has persisted for more than 2 years and we wish both parents and students can remain positive towards both their learning and examination result. In case your child encounter any problems with their studies, feel free to seek help from either class teachers, subject teachers or counselling teachers

4.3 The water fountain and tuck shop of the School will not be in operation in view of the pandemic, students therefore have to bring their own drinking water for their school days.

4.4 Anti-pandemic measures and personal hygiene

- The school campus has been thoroughly cleaned and sanitized during the special holiday whilst all staff have stepped up on all anti-virus measures to safeguard both personal and school hygiene. The School has also requested all staff to take antigen test and body temperature before coming to work and call in sick when the test reads positive, fever in particular.
- In order that students can do their learning in a clean and safe environment, home-school cooperation is of utmost importance. We urge parents to observe household hygiene and put into practice the following measures:
 - Pay heed to your child's daily medical condition, seek immediate medical advice if he/she develops symptoms, fever in particular, and call in sick to apply for sick leave
 - Take body temperature and antigen test of your child every day before he/she leaves home for school and complete/endorse the record sheet in Appendix 3. In case the test reads positive, students should not come to school and report to CHP as per request from the government.
 - The School reserves the right to do random check and request for repeated test; or provide antigen test kit for students to undergo testing upon approval of parents concerned. Students who cannot complete the necessary testing in time are not allowed to attend classes and parents will be notified by the School to fetch home these students.
 - To guard against infection, please urge your child to wear surgical mask and bring alongside hand sanitizers and tissues whilst commuting between school and home.
 - Students who were infected and recovered but still in the specific quarantine period should not come to school; students whose residence was subject to Compulsory Testing Direction should not come to school; or students who are under Prevention and Control of Disease Ordinance (Cap. 599) (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) classified as Persons subject to Compulsory Testing should take specified test at his/her earliest convenience and should not come to school before getting a negative result which should be presented with evident proof like mobile SMS or Test Result. Students who cannot return to school during the waiting period will be given discretionary consideration of their absence.
 - Parents should contact Ms Siu Man-yee, the Teacher-in-charge of School Affairs at 25779485 in the following situations so that the School can take proper measures:
 - Your child is preliminarily confirmed of COVID-19,
 - Your child is defined as close contact of confirmed COVID-19 cases or sharing the same residence with the close contact of confirmed COVID-19 cases,
 - Your child is classified as person subject to compulsory testing Under Cap.599 Ordinance; and
 - Your child is residing in buildings subject to Compulsory Testing Direction and hence cannot leave home for the School.

- Vaccination is the most effective means of protection against COVID-19, and can minimize the risk of falling seriously sick or unwanted fatality. The School therefore urges parents to arrange for your child to be vaccinated in the soonest future.

In view of the volatility of COVID-19, the School will pay close attention to announcement of EDB. May we remind you to stay alert for updates released on the School website and myIDChanel Plus app. For any queries, feel free to contact the class teacher on 25779485.

May we also call for your cooperation to remind your child to avoid crowds to minimize the risk of getting infected with COVID-19. We look forward to resumption of regular healthy lives as the virus impact subsides.

Body Temperature and Antigen Test for COVID-19 Record Sheet

1. Parents/Guardians should take their children's body temperature before going to school. For normal body temperature range, please refer to the "Reference Range for Temperature Screening" in the "Guidance Note on Monitoring of Body Temperature" by the Centre for Health Protection, Please browse https://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/guidance_note_on_monitoring_of_body_temperature.pdf. If your child has a fever (oral temperature higher than 37.5°C/99.5°F or ear temperature higher than 38°C / 100.4°F), When the student has fever, he/she should not attend school and should consult a doctor promptly, apply for sick leave, stay at home and take rest.
2. Students should take Antigen Test for COVID-19 every day for negative reading before leaving home for school. Students should refrain from going to school if their test result reads positive, stay home, notify the school and report to Health Department via <https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp/> within the next 24 hours.
3. Parents/Guardians should record their children's body temperature and sign on the record sheet daily. The record sheet should be returned to class teacher for checking.
