## Summer Bridging Course

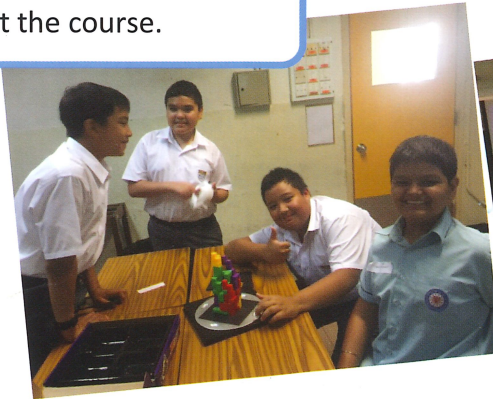
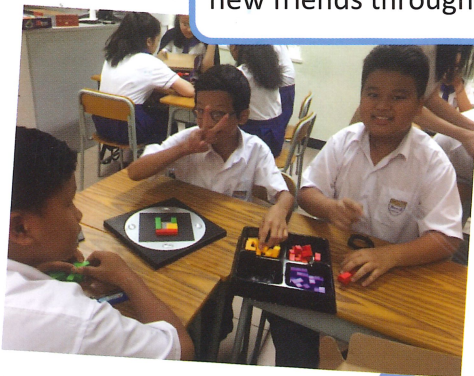
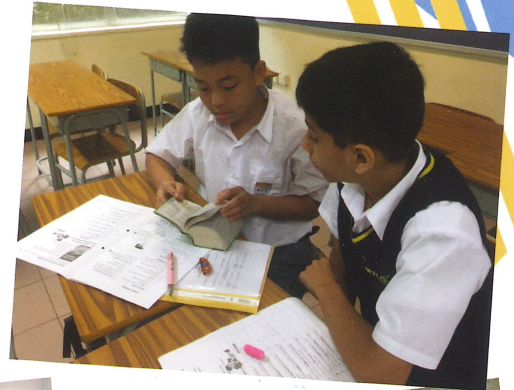
The course ensures students a smooth transition to their secondary school life. New students got the chance to experience new subjects like I.H. and Science through games and fun activities.
